## 55th West Lancashire Division L.O.L. 1915

### Lodge Byelaws

1. Membership by affiliation is open to all members of the Loyal Orange Institution (male and female) in good standing.
2. Prospective Members must provide information and an Application Fee, set by the Lodge assembled before being accepted as Members.
3. Prospective Members will receive a copy of these byelaws prior to admission and must confirm they have read them and agreed to the same.
4. Members of the Lodge will be required to pay Annual Dues, which shall be payable in full, in advance, at the January meeting each year.
5. Membership of the Lodge shall automatically be revoked if Annual Dues have been unpaid for 1 year.
6. Any Member who resigns from the Loyal Orange Institution will no longer be entitled to be a member of this Lodge.
7. The Lodge shall meet at least four times a year.
  - a.) Meeting date, time and location to be agreed at Lodge assembled on an invitation basis.
  - b.) Meeting date, time and location to be circulated to members by the Secretary.
  - c.) The month of April will be inclusive of the election of Officers.
  - d.) The month of July / August will be inclusive of the installation of Officers.
8. Lodge Regalia – A Jewel is available from the Lodge and will be worn as Lodge regalia at meeting assembled. Anyone who is no longer a member of this Lodge will not be entitled to wear the jewel under any circumstances.
9. NO alcoholic drinks to be brought into the Lodge room at any time.
10. NO games of chance to be played whilst the Lodge be open for the conducting of business.
11. Preferred method of communication to Members will be via email and thus keeping costs down to the Lodge.
12. All Officers of the 55<sup>th</sup> West Lancashire Division will have attained the degree of:-
  - a.) Male Members - Royal Arch Purple
  - b.) Female Members – Purple
- 13.) Dress code of the Lodge assembled will be a minimum of collar and tie for male members. Sisters to be suitably dressed as befits this dress code.
